



Garville Umpires Policy 2016

Garville provides a structured pathway and development program for officials and aligns with Netball SA programs and accreditations.

Garville has a Umpire Development Officer and an Umpire coordinator to carry out the development and provide opportunities for our umpires to advance from beginners to higher levels.

The Club Umpiring Policy is monitored by the Management committee

- All umpires shall be registered with the NSA Umpire's association
- All umpires will be provided with an Umpire's manual
- All umpires will complete a Level 1 Certificate as a minimum
- Garville will develop umpires through a Coloured Shirt Program
- Umpires shall at all times represent the Club with dignity and sportsmanlike behaviour
- Umpires will be provided with whistles and jackets and season passes
- Umpires will attend all development programs as required by the Development Officer
- Umpires shall continue to keep up to date with rule changes and interpretations as directed by Netball Australia
- Umpires shall remain detached and neutral when officiating at matches
- Umpires shall remain detached from team issues and sideline issues when officiating at matches
- Mentoring will be provided to all umpires and feedback given
- Umpires will adhere to all club policies regarding Codes of behaviour:
 - Anti-Harassment, Abuse and Bullying
 - Umpires Code of Behaviour
